COVID-19 General Policies

- We have instituted a COVID-19 Task Force with our community partners including but not limited to our OEM, the Superintendents of Schools, our community hospital administration, elected officials from the municipalities, law enforcement, first responders, etc. which meets weekly or more often should it become necessary.
- We have discontinued visitation at our long term care facility and instituted Skype and Facetime for our residents (and they are quite excited to learn this technology!) Those on hospice and nearing end of life are allowed visitors who will enter through a separate entrance and be screened.
- No out of County work related travel is allowed. We are attempting to seek reimbursement for related costs and this has self cured in some instances as the hosts are cancelling the conferences per CDC guidelines for group gatherings.
- Many local meetings and County sponsored events are being cancelled and we are moving to conference calls where appropriate.
- I am meeting with all department heads to review their COOP-COG plans.
- Our Senior Centers are closing beginning Monday 3/16 and meals will be delivered to those in need by Center staff.
- Our Health Department is updating staff and community partners daily as information and guidelines continue to be put forth as accurate communication is key.
