“We’re very excited about the opportunity to once again partner with Rutgers on this unique continuing education initiative designed for our county administrators, finance officers, department heads, professional staff, and elected officials,” said NJAC President and Hudson County Freeholder Jeffrey Dublin.

Since last year’s inaugural class was such a tremendous success, NJAC is offering two programs this year open to all local government employees and elected officials committed to advancing their careers in public service. All successful program graduates will receive a certificate from Rutgers University verifying their completion of training.
